

Redwood Electric Cooperative 2017 Rebate Programs

Recipients must be a REC member and the appliance/equipment must be installed within the cooperative's territory and the appliance/equipment MUST be purchased in 2017. The program will end when funds are exhausted; additional rebates may be added at a later date. Appliance rebates \$100 or less will be credited to the members account. Any rebate amount over \$100 or any other rebate will be issued as a check to the member.

The completed applications will be processed on a first come first served basis as they are received in our office. Any incomplete applications will not be processed. Please make sure all required information is sent in with the application form. Rebate applications can be requested by calling our Clements office or found on our website.
